QUICK GUIDE TO: SENDING IN CONTRIBUTIONS

Be sure to include a breakdown of gifts (even if it is just one gift) with all donations so it is clear who the donor is (including ID number), what fund to support, and the total amount of the gift.

Plan to mail all checks through express mail if you are coming up on a deadline like 30% Goal, 60% Goal, 100% Goal, and June 30.

This will be the fastest and easiest way to ensure your gift has made it to Headquarters before a deadline.

When multiple donors are giving via one credit card, please type "See Breakdown" in the Donor Name field. Email us the summary form or a listing of donors (please include the correct donor numbers) with the donors who should receive credit as soon as, if not before, the gift is made. If you are using a chapter debit card you will likely have to call the bank to approve any large contributions.

RP SPECIFIC

RP: Research Promotion

RVC: Regional Vice Chair

PAOE: Presidential Award of Excellence (recognition for your hard work)

Volunteer Committee: Chapter members who will help you reach or exceed Goal

Full Circle: Financial support from your Chapter Board; leadership giving

Donor Recognition: Saying thank you to recent donors

Challenge Goal: 120% of Goal, or 105% of High Five (lower of the two)

High Five: The highest amount raised in five years

APEX Award: Hitting a new high for 4 of the past 5 years

Succession Plan: Planning ahead for your chapter to make the transition from one year to the next easier

FUNDRAISING SPECIFIC

Endowment or Endowed Fund: Donations held in the Foundation to generate interest. The interest is then spent on the fund being supported by the endowment. The 5% interest does count in your Chapter RP Campaign each year.

Scholarship: A type of endowed fund, this is held by the Foundation and supported by donations. Interest is awarded to a student – the 5% does NOT count in your Chapter RP Campaign.

LYBUNT: Donors who gave Last Year, But Unfortunately Not This (year)

SYBUNT: Donors who gave Some Years, But Unfortunately Not This (year)

- Log-in using your member e-mail and password *(if you need this info, contact Staff or go through "Forgot Password" on ashrae.org)*

Available Reports

10 Year History:

- Used to find LYBUNTs and SYBUNTs
 - Send letters and conduct calling campaigns
- Past giving history
- How and when a donor gave
- Finding ID/member numbers

Donor Detail:

- Year-To-Date donors
- Run monthly
- Credited properly
- On-line gifts

Chapter Officers:

- Used for Full Circle and FC+
- Contact information for your board

Make Note:

- The 10 Year History report is based on the Home chapter. If a donor with your chapter listed as the Home chapter, but gives to another chapter, this will reflect on your 10 Year History even though your chapter is not receiving credit for this gift.
- Your Donor Detail report is the best report to use when trying to find your year-to-date total. This report pulls by gift, not donor.
- These are updated as gifts are entered into the Accounting database.

The Spreadsheet

- Found on www.ashraerp.com
- Updated once a month through March then twice a month through the end of the Campaign
- Tracks your campaign to date and compares to last year's results
- Tracks your chapter's PAOE totals
